Dress Code Policy

Policy

The purpose of this policy is to clarify the dress code for all students at Saddleworth Primary School.

Rationale

At Saddleworth Primary School we believe that compliance with the dress code promotes a sense of belonging, encourages responsible behaviour, pride in our school and enhances our public image.

Objectives

The Governing Council has determined the following school dress code and endorses the wearing of this school uniform for all students attending Saddleworth Primary School.

Navy shorts, navy skorts, navy pants or navy track pants (no stripes or logos)

Navy polo top

White or navy long sleeve top may be worn underneath polo tops

Navy hooded jumper

Rugby jumper

Chequered blue summer dress

Navy or tartan skirt or pinafore

Navy hat

Navy beanie

Year 6 students may wear the Year 6 student top

Sport

Students will be provided with a school athletic singlet for interschool sports. Sports day tops are provided by the school for each house team.

Cold Weather

Scarves, gloves and jackets may be worn during winter months, preferably in school colours.

Hair & Jewellery

In order to promote safe environment that is conducive to learning, long hair should be worn up or tied back. Any excessive jewellery or accessories deemed to be unsafe and not appropriate for school will be managed at the Principal's discretion.

Casual Days

Students are encouraged to wear school appropriate casual clothing and footwear. In line with the schools SunSmart Policy shoulders and midriffs need to be covered.

Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of staff to encourage the dress code. The Principal may grant an exemption when a request is made in writing.

It is the responsibility of students to wear the appropriate uniform at all times including on excursions.

It is the parent's responsibility to ensure students wear the appropriate uniform and support staff in enforcing the policy.
